


Dear All,

**Samuel Helfont** is an <u>Assistant Professor of Strategy and Policy</u> in the Naval War College program at the Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey, California. He is also an <u>Affiliate Scholar</u> in the Abbasi Program in Islamic Studies at Stanford University and a <u>Senior Fellow</u> at the Foreign Policy Research Institute in Philadelphia. His research focuses on international history and politics in the Middle East, especially Iraq and the Iraq Wars. He is the author of <u>Compulsion in Religion: Saddam Hussein, Islam, and the Roots of Insurgencies in Iraq</u> (Oxford University Press, 2018).

Helfont holds a PhD and MA in Near Eastern Studies from Princeton University. Prior to moving to Monterey, he completed a three year post-doctoral lectureship at the University of Pennsylvania. He has also served as a Visiting Assistant Professor at Haverford College, and was the recipient of US Scholar Research Support Fellowship from the Hoover Library and Archives at Stanford University.
